Literacy

In Literacy we will be writing our own warning story. We will consider how the author creates atmosphere in a warning story and how he uses dialogue and description to show the reader what is happening.

Our SPaG will focus on relative clauses, using () - and , to add more information and modal verbs.

Numeracy

This half term we will be focusing on multiplication and division.

Children will be identifying factors and multiples of numbers and will learn about prime numbers, squared and cubed numbers.

They will be learning how to multiply a 3 digit number by a 2 digit number and how to use short division.

It is **essential** that children practice their times tables at home regularly so that they know all multiplication and division facts up to 12 x 12 confidently and quickly.

Science

We are continuing our unit of learning about materials. The children will learn about the difference between melting and dissolving and plan their own investigations to find out more. The children will work scientifically and collaboratively to investigate different ways to separate mixtures of materials, using filtering, sieving and evaporating. Finally, they will learn about irreversible changes.



Geography/History (Topic)

In topic we will continue to learn about World War 2. We will look at how people kept their moral during the war and about their home lives. We will then look at how the war affected those living in Germany. We will end our unit by looking at how the war ended and how people celebrated.



SMSC

RE

In RE, our topic will be 'Words of wisdom'.

PSHE

We will be continuing our unit on 'I am unique.'

We will look at our feelings and emotions and how we react to different situations. We will learn about how to see things from other's perspectives to understand how everyone is valued.

We will also focus lessons around anti-bullying week. We will learn about why people bully and how we can address it and help others who are being bullied.

PE

This half time Year five will be having PE on a Friday morning. Please make sure that your child has an indoor and outdoor kit in school on this day.

Art/DT

Our Art and DT will be linked to our topic. We will finish our own box Anderson Shelters and evaluate them. We will then develop our sketching skills by drawing pictures related to Remembrance Day.



Homework

Reading: Children need to be reading to an adult at least 3 x a week. Please make sure their diary is signed so they can earn the reading reward!

Spelling: Children will be given spellings each week to learn and they will be tested every Thursday.

Times Tables: Children are progressing through their times tables and know which one they are on. They need to learn the multiplication and division facts. EG $7 \times 9 = 63$ $63 \div 7 = 9$. They need to know these in mixed order and be able to answer in less than 5 seconds.

Other: There will either be a numeracy or SPaG homework linked to the work we have been doing in class. It will be handed out each Friday and needs to be returned by Wednesday.

It is the children's responsibility to ensure that this homework is completed by the day required and they will need to stay in and complete it if it is not done.
